Entry Form - Only entries received on the official **AKA entry form will be accepted.**

Entries Close 21st January 2010 –LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES. If Fewer than 8 entries in a class then that class will be withdrawn and entry fee returned.

FORMAT OF RACING - Method of Racing: STATE SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIPS:

1. UNDERSUBSCRIBED CLASSES:

a) 2 x 4 timed qualifying sessions.

b) Heat one **10 laps** : Grid positions as per qualifying (fastest time to grid position one, and so on)

Heat two **10 laps** : Grid positions as per qualifying (fastest time to grid position one, and so on)

c) One (1) pre- final **14 laps** . Lowest points from heats one and two to Grid One, and so on.

d) One (1) Final **21 laps** : The finishing order from Pre-Final to Grid 1, and so on, non finishers in the pre final will be gridded at the rear of the field in order of laps completed, then grid position from pre final.

2. OVER-SUBSCRIBED CLASSES:

a) 2 x 4 timed Qualifying Sessions.

After timed qualifying all but the last five (5) grid positions are filled immediately for the heats. The last five (5) positions for the heats are filled from the results of the REPECHARGE RACE between the remainder of the competitors up to track capacity.

(b) One (1) Repercharge **8 laps** - grid positions as per qualifying (faster time to grid position one, and so on)

(c) Heat 1 **10 laps** - grid positions as per qualifying (fastest time to grid position one, and so on) plus first five place getters from repercharge

Heat 2 **10 laps** - grid positions as per qualifying (fastest time to grid position one, and so on) plus first five place getters from repechage.

(d) One (1) Pre-Final **14 laps** : - Lowest points from heats 1 and 2 to grid 1, and so on.

(e) One (1) Final **21 laps** : The finishing order from Pre-Final to grid 1, and so on, non finishers in the pre final will be gridded at the rear of the field in order of laps completed, then grid position from pre final.

- (a) All competitors must register a qualifying time and compete in the first heat to be eligible for grid positions for the Pre-Final and final.
- (b) Karts underweight will be excluded (refer R 5.03) except during timed qualifying when R19.17 (e) applies.
- (c) Ties between karts on points from Heats will be decided by Qualifying position.
- (d) Point Score System for Heats:
 - 1st - 0 Points
 - 2nd - 2 Points
 - 3rd - 3 Points and so on with one point being added for each place.
- (e) Non-starters and non-finishers to be awarded a finishing position based on the number of laps completed, then the grid position awarded from the start of the heat.

Finishing Order of the final determines the winning positions in each Championship Class.

Drivers excluded during qualifying will be allocated the slowest time plus 1 second or as determined by the officials.

Drivers disqualified during any race will be allocated points penalties as determined by the officials.

Numbers:

25.13 Number Plates:

- (i) Front and rear numbers must be a minimum of 130 mm high and 20 mm wide and conform to the text font - as per sample diagram below. They must be spaced a minimum of 15 mm apart and have a minimum 15 mm border of the approved background colour around the number. For double digit numbers the background colour must be one piece.
- (ii) Side pod numbers must be a minimum of 100 mm high and 15 mm wide and conform to the text font – as per sample diagram below. They must be spaced a minimum 15 mm apart and be a minimum of 15 mm of the approved background colour around the number. For double digit numbers the background colour must be one piece. Side numbers are required to be mounted on both sides of the kart, and shall be on the outside of the side pods. Lap scorers decision re legibility is final.

The blue and red double diagonal flag **will be used** during this meeting. Refer Rule 15.13

The organisers reserve the right at their sole discretion to abandon, postpone or cancel any event(s) subject to Rule 11.09.

Trophies:

Plaques will be awarded to the Fastest Time Qualifier in each class.

Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th & 5th place will be presented.

Blue number plate will be awarded to the 1st place getter only.

Insurance:

Insurance has been affected for this meeting in accordance with Chapter 3.

Noise Levels: Maximum permissible noise levels shall be in accordance with Chapter 24

Fuel: As per the 2010 AKA Karting Manual.

Controlled fuel for use during this meeting is **Shell Premium unleaded, from Shell Service station corner of Boundry and Centre Dandenong Road Dingley**

Fuel may be purchased from Wednesday 10th February 2010 **BUT** the control fuel must be used from Friday 12th February 2010 through to Sunday 14th February 2010 inclusive.

Random samples of competitor's fuel will be taken during this meeting and tested for conformity to samples taken from the supplier between these dates.

REMINDER: Fuel tanks and drums should be empty prior to being used for fuel purchased for this meeting.

Judges of Fact: As per rule 4.17

Pit crew attire - Rule 14 .12 ,13.15 ,1.05 : All pit crew shall be required to wear suitable attire, including shoes, and observe any other requirements on protective clothing in these rules.

Trailers / Cars: **No Vehicles are permitted in the Pit Area. Trailers only in allocation area if size permits.**
Pit space 6m x 3m and 3 x 3 only
All vehicles and trailers are to be parked in the designated parking areas allocated.
No roping off –Pit Allocation by Pit Marshalls only

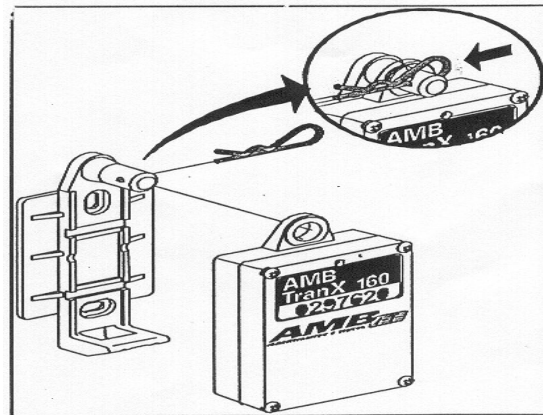
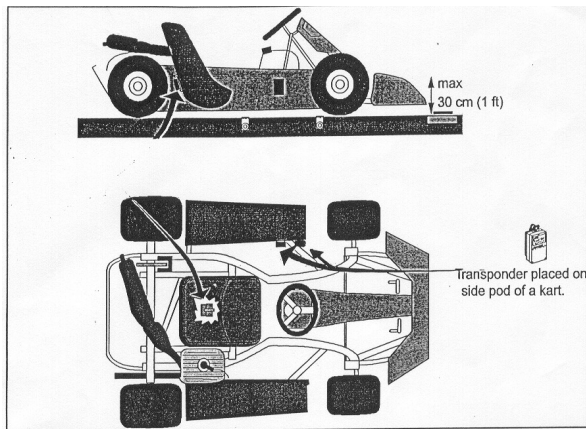
Personal Transponders:

There will be no transponders issued by VKA or OGKRC for this race meeting, all karters must provide their own transponder.

AMB TRANX 160 - It will be compulsory for all competitors to have an AMB TranX160 transponder fitted to their karts for the purposes of lap timing and / or lap scoring recording in all qualifying sessions and competition, in conjunction with the AKA Race Management System, **All karts must have their own transponder fitted.**

Fitting, Maintenance and Performance: Competitors will be responsible at all times for the correct fitting (rule 25.30), maintenance and performance of the transponder in all sections of events contested. Competitors who fail to comply with this rule will be automatically excluded from the section of the event to which the offence relates, unless rule 19.17 (d) applies, or, the fault is with the organisers of the event. Action will be taken by the issue of a Penalty Notification Form which will be issued without an Officials Hearing and signed by at least one Steward and the Chief Timing Officer (Judge of Fact).

Transponder holder brackets will be available for purchase at the circuit at a cost of **\$10.00** inc GST, Transponders **must** be fitted facing the driver, on the left-hand side pod 300mm from the kingpin.



Engine Sealing:

All motors must be fitted with sealing nuts appropriate for the respective type of engine unless specifically noted in class regulations. A Sealing Nut is an extended head or cylinder nut that has a minimum 3mm hole through one end that will allow the fitting of an engine seal/tag. The nut must not be able to turn or be removed once fitted with a seal.

1. Engines with integral cylinder and head studs:
 - The two (2) sealing nuts must be adjacent and the 3mm holes must be above the head fins NOT to have a through hole.
2. Engines with head studs independent of cylinder studs:
 - The two (2) sealing nuts must have the 3mm holes above the cylinder fins and be adjacent.
 - One internal hex cylindrical cylinder nut (cylinder to crankcase) to be fitted on the drive side, NOT to have a through hole (for ease of checking).
3. Water Cooled Engines:
 - Two (2) head studs to be replaced by sealing nuts.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

No animals allowed. No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the circuit. No motorised scooters, scooters, mini bikes, bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the event.
